21T15 Who Owns You?

Hello my friends. Thanks for joining me at the PUNLA coffee table. So, get your coffee or tea and Get comfortable so we can talk.

Before we start. If anything I say today is useful to you, it proves God can use even a person like me. If what I say is folly, then that's all me. I'm human and I am flawed.

So, I'm sure my title has offended many of you. Who Owns You? Until the last couple of hundred years, this would not have been such a controversial question. Until the rise of the United States in 1776, the concept of democracy was not widely known. Most countries where some form of a dictatorship. Kingdoms with Kings in charge. People who lived in a kingdom called the leader, the king or Lord. The word lord is defined as "someone or something having power, authority, or influence; Master or Ruler.

A King or a Master or a Lord, these are interchangeable terms essentially. These have authority and control over their subjects.

So let me ask you again in a softer way. Who is your master? Who is your Lord? Who are you subject to?

I'm sure most of you said no one. But is that really true. You might say I control my life. Nobody tells me what to do. But that is a lie. I'll use myself as an example. I'm a father to my children. I'm their master. They have to do what I tell them to do or face the consequences. And I can go on.

I'm a subject as well. Don't laugh but my wife is my master. She owns me. Our marriage contract purchased me. I have to do what she tells me to or face the consequences.

I'm a subject of the state of Texas. I live in Texas. I'm a citizen of Texas, that makes me a subject of the state of Texas. The State Government is my Master. If I don't do what they tell me to do, then I face the consequences. They can take my money, my property, my children and even me. They can put me in prison which takes away my freedom if I don't do as they tell me. They even have the authority to put me to death if I break certain rules.

I'm a subject of the United States of America. I live in the United States of America. I'm a citizen of the United States which makes me a subject of the United States of America. The U.S. Government is my Master. If I don't do what they tell me to do, then I face the consequences. They can take my money, my property, and even me. They

can put me in prison which takes away my freedom if I don't do as they tell me. They can force me into their direct service. They used to call this the Draft for military service. They even have the authority to put me to death if I break certain rules.

Whichever master has the greatest authority is your owner. They ultimately decide what happens to you. As long as you live and work within their boundaries, you probably won't feel their control but it is there none-the-less.

So, let me ask you again. Who Owns You? Did your answer change? Did your distain for my question change?

The real question for each of us is. Who is our greatest authority? Then that is who owns you.

Every human gets to choose, who their greatest authority is. You can choose another human or humans, or you can choose the highest authority God.

Now remember like it or not, for most of us, many people have authority over us. And each "master", person or institution have the authority to take or give things, to or from us. Remember all institutions whether government or private companies are run by people.

So let me answer the question for me. I'm owned by Jesus. Why He bought me. Galatians 3:13 (NKJV) ¹³<u>Christ has redeemed us</u> from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), or Acts 20:28 (NKJV) Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which <u>He</u> <u>purchased with His own blood</u>.
