

What is a worldview?

- Worldview is a comprehensive collection of attitudes, values, and expectations about the world around us.
- How we live; the rules, ethics, morals, etc.



6 Worldviews

<u>Monotheism</u>

- o Judaism
 - ✓ God revealed in Scripture through Moses & Prophets
 - ✓ Hope in a Messiah yet to come
- o Islamic
 - ✓ Quran is infallible word of Allah
- Reach paradise by following laws of Allah
 Jesus is not God, nor did he die for sins
- Christianity
 - ✓ Messiah is Jesus
 - ✓ Christ came & died to pay penalty for sin
 - ✓ Christ will return (new heaven & earth)



Deism

God created an orderly world to operate on its own.



<u>Naturalism</u>

Matter is all that exists, and it is best understood through science.



<u>Nihilism</u>

Nothing. Truth, values, consciousness should be questioned.



Existentialism

Life has no meaning. Significance by a created personality.



<u>Pantheism</u>

Everything that exists is god (spirit). Matter is an illusion.


