<u>Law of Non-contradiction</u> Contradictory propositions	All Truth is Absolute


Contradictory propositions cannot both be true!

To deny is to use it.

All Truth is Absolute
Something that is true is true
for ALL people
at ALL times
in ALL places.

Objections to Absolute Truth

- 1. There is no truth!
- 2. You can't know truth!
- 3. All Truth is relative!
- 4. It's true for you... but not for me!
- 5. No one has the truth!
- 6. You ought not judge!



Examples of Turning Claim on Itself

	"There is no truth."
	"It's true for you but not for me."
	"There is no truth in anything but science."
	"You can't know the real world."
C	"You should doubt everything."
P	"You should not judge."

MATTHEW 7:1-2 (NLT)

Do not judge others, and you will not be judged. For you will be treated as you treat others. The **standard you use** in judging is the standard by which you will be judged.

Truth about Truth

- ✓ Contrary <u>beliefs</u> are possible, but contrary <u>truths</u> are not possible.
- ✓ You can <u>believe</u> everything is true, but everything <u>cannot</u> be true.
- ✓ Objective truth cannot be <u>denied</u> without being <u>affirmed</u>.
