



Objection to Absolute Truth

- There is no truth! Is that true?
- You can't know truth! How do you know that is true?
- All Truth is relative!
 - That sounds absolute?
- It's true for you... but not for me! Is it true for everybody?
- No one has the truth! Is that true?
- You ought not judge! Isn't that a judgment?

 - Absolutely Morally Perfect

Inerrancy

- Inerrancy means no contradictions.
- "Inerrancy in that men are often in error, but the Bible is not; it is truth" – Kip
