### Evidence of God (Moral Argument)

- (1) If God does not exist,  
objective moral values and duties do not exist.
  - (2) Objective moral values and duties do exist.
  - (3) Therefore, God Exists

### Mark 1:1-3 (Jesus the Messiah)

- Messiah = Anointed One (Hebrew mashiach)
  - Christ = Anointed One (Greek christos)
  - Is. 40:1-5 (a voice calling in wilderness)
  - Mal. 3:1 (messenger to prepare the way)

### Mark 1:4-8 (John the Baptist)

- Camel Wool Clothes & Eating Bugs
  - the voice in the wilderness

### Mark 1:9-11 (Baptism of Jesus)

- Spirit of God, Father God, Son of God
  - Baptism = Baptisma(Latin) = Baptizo(Greek) “to dip”
  - Hebrew tevilah “to be immersed” Tevilah is ritual cleansing by immersion in water.

### Mark 1:13-15 (the good news of God)

- Greek ‘euaggelion’ -> good news
  - Latin ‘evangelium’ -> good news (evangelism)
  - Old English ‘godspel’ -> good news (gospel)
  - Matt. 4:23; 9:35; 24:14 (gospel of the kingdom)
