	What Defiles a Man - Mark 7:14-23 (Matt. 14:10-20)
can't hope if we don't know what to hope for	<ol> <li>Jesus redefines defilement, Moral and Ceremonial</li> <li>Ceremonially Impure (unclean) applies only to Jewish traditional temple worship.</li> <li>Morally Impure (unclean), is behavior that is against God's plan. Requires repentance.</li> <li>True Defilement comes out of the human heart and mind, not what we eat.</li> </ol>
Can't have satisfaction without knowing our purpose	<ul><li>a. Why do physical things defile?</li><li>b. Why do thoughts defile?</li><li>c. Why do words defile?</li></ul>
