John 3:16-21 ("God so loved the world")	Listen/Read to Mark 9:1-29 using ASND/TCB
Loving Character of God	Transfiguration: Mark 9:1-13 (Matt. 17:1-13; Luke 9:28-36; 2 Peter 1:16-21) 1) What does Jesus mean, :some will not taste death
Romans 5:6-9 ("while we were still sinners") – God is Just	before the kingdom of God arrives? Possible answer: Jesus says the kingdom of God is where He is. I think Jesus is referring to the resurrection where He conquered death and sin. Why Elijah and Moses? Possible answer: Elijah represents the Prophets and Moses represents the Law. The Book of Hebrews demonstrates that Jesus is greater than these. v.12. Elijah came 1st. Who is Jesus talking about? Possible answer: Other gospel account show that John the Baptist came is the spirit of Elijah.

James 4:1-4 ("pray for selfish reasons") – Righteousness of God (God's will, not our will)	trust God at times, we need to pray for help to overcome our unbelief
