Mark 16:8 (NIV) **Trembling and bewildered**, the women went out and **fled** from the tomb. They said nothing to anyone, because they **were afraid**.

Mark 16:10-11 (NIV) ¹⁰She went and told those who had been with him and who were mourning and weeping. ¹¹When they heard that Jesus was alive and that she had seen him, **they did not believe it**.

Mark 16:12-13 (NIV) ¹²Afterward Jesus appeared in a different form to two of them while they were walking in the country. ¹³These returned and reported it to the rest; but **they did not believe them either**.

Matthew 28:16-17 (NIV) ¹⁶Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. ¹⁷When they saw him, they worshiped him; **but some doubted**.

1) Read Mark 15:22-47

Mark 15:1-21 (Group Study)

Listen/Read to Mark 15:1-21 using ASND/TCB

Jesus before Pilate Mark 15:1-5 (Matt. 27:1-2)

1) Why was Pilate amazed by Jesus?

Possible answer: it probably has more to do with Jesus than the actual words. His confidence.

Barabbas Mark 15:6-15 (Matt. 27:24-26)

2) Why Barabbas?

Possible answer: Pilate choose the worst to compare to Jesus, hoping the crowd would choose Jesus. Pilate's words, "what has He done?"

Mocked and flogged Mark 15:16-21

(Matt. 27:27-31; Luke 22:63-65; John 19:1-16)

3) Cruelty of man?

Possible answer: Jesus was rejected by His people, abandoned by His friends, beaten, torture and mocked. This is what we deserve and Jesus took the punishment for us.
